even picked up a couple of extra extended magazines to carry on the side, which is what Mr. Moon recommended, so your carry can remain small and compact, and you still have larger magazines if needed. Here are a few words from Justin Moon about how and why.

In self-defense situations, the shooter will be under stress with adrenaline pumping. Consequently, the shooter may lose fine motor control of the fingers which makes the Kahr design best for both safe carry and accurate shooting during stressful situations. This is highly preferable to triggers that are too short or light. Accuracy and weapon control are absolutely required in self-defense situations. The smooth revolver-like trigger enables accurate fire at a rate that is controllable for self-defense applications.

From its inception, Kahr Arms has designed pistols that are dimensionally smaller and thinner than any other pistol of the same caliber. For example, the Kahr 9mm is only 9 inch thick at the slide and on the grip frame. The pistol is extremely comfortable to carry and conceal. Even with pistol strapped to your belt, you can comfortably sit in a car with bucket seats. The Kahr pistol advantages in concealment include the magazine and base. We have designed the mag bases to maintain a dimension that approximates, and does not increase, the size of the magazine. Manufacturers that have recently entered the concealed carry market have produced magazine bases which fit the grip frame of their small pistols. In effect, they made a small gun with a big magazine. This does not make sense for concealed carry since spare magazines also need to be concealed.

Each Kahr pistol is built with materials of the highest quality. Kahr's components are manufactured to the tightest possible tolerances. As a result, all of our pistols are superbly accurate. Kahr pistols will shoot as accurately as the shooter's skill and ammo quality permits. A trained shooter with a Kahr pistol can make hits on a man-sized target even at 100 yards. Because of our quality, we at Kahr take pride in each and every pistol. Kahr has consistently strived to provide excellent customer service and support during the past 20 years and remains committed to superior customer service for years to come.
